



# Impact of the New Coronavirus around Inuyama


Due to the Influence of the new coronavirus the employment situation has deteriorated in Inuyama. As of August, the number of job seekers registered at the Public Employment Security Office in Inuyama was 897 people more than last year, an increase of 8.7%. On the other hand, the number of job offers decreased by 1,132 people compared to last year, a decrease of 22.6%. Foreign workers have also been affected. The number of new job applications for foreigners exceeded 100 people in June, which is about 3.6 times greater than of last year. However, the number of job vacancies in the manufacturing industry, which employs many foreigners, decreased by 52.6% from April to August.




April~ August Change

# **<To Applicants Wishing to Apply for Short-Term Loans>**

① For Temporary Loss of Work (Small short-term loan)	
Repayment Schedule	The loan must be repaid within three years

② For households that have become unemployed (comprehensive support funds)


\*These funds are for households that are struggling for their living expenses despite receiving an emergency small short-term loan above (1)

Repayment Schedule These funds must be repaid within 11 years

According to the Inuyama Social Welfare Council, 332 households applied for temporary special loans as of September 30. Foreign people numbered 136, about 40% of the total.
